Who can use UHS?

- Full-time students are assessed the health fee with their mandatory fees and tuition.
- Part-time students can voluntarily pay the health fee or be seen on a fee for service basis.
- Summer coverage available with optional health fee or on a fee for service basis.

What Is University Health Service?

- University Health Service is an on-campus clinic available for student use.

 - Gynecology/Genitourinary Care Clinic
 - Nursing Clinic
 - Behavioral Health Clinic
 - Health Education and Wellness Services





What does the Health Fee Cover?

Unlimited office visits for:

- Injury or illness
- Allergy injections
- Well-patient, travel, and employment physical exams
- Gynecology/Genitourinary
- Observation room care
- Phone information nurse
- On-call physician for emergency after hours

- Limited medications
- Behavioral Health office visits
- Health education and wellness services:
 - Nutrition Counseling
 - Health and Wellness Coaching
 - Tobacco Treatment Counseling
 - Sexual Health Education Sessions



What is *NOT* Covered under the Health Fee?

The health fee is designed to cover primary care and preventive medicine. Items not covered by the health fee include:

- Diagnostic testing (X-rays, most lab tests)
- Hospitalization
- After hours care: Urgent Treatment, Emergency Room
- Surgical procedures
- Referrals to specialists
- Prescriptions
- Vaccines



Students are encouraged to have health insurance to cover these expenses.

Vaccinations

- University of Kentucky <u>requires</u> <u>Quadrivalent Meningitis</u> (Men ACWY) vaccine for all students living in campus housing with the second vaccine being on or after the 16th birthday.
- The University of Kentucky <u>strongly recommends</u> that all incoming students be immunized before enrollment against the following illnesses:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Polio, Varicella, Tetanus/Tdap, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Hepatitis B, HPV and both Quadrivalent Meningitis (Men ACWY) & Meningitis B Vaccine

Immunization records can be received in two ways:

- 1. Log in to https://myuk.uky.edu/irj/portal, My Info, Student Services, Student health to access the online patient portal for University Health Service (student health). click on "upload" and follow the instructions (This must be done by the student using their Link Blue ID).


