RIGHT AWAY

- While you may receive mail from the Office of Orientation to your personal email address, advisors will use only your UK email address. Visit ukam.uky.edu or the UK Email Accounts page in your Canvas course to double-check your email settings.

- Review your advising profile in myUK. Instructions in Canvas.
- Some of our placement tests require you to complete practice modules, so begin this process as soon as possible. Learn more at orientation.uky.edu/placement-testing.

7 DAYS PRIOR

- Your college will send you details about how and when you should meet with your advisor at least 7 days prior to your orientation. **You may be required to schedule an appointment with your advisor in advance of your orientation.** If you do not receive advising information from your college or instructions on how to schedule a meeting, please email us at orientation@uky.edu.
- Major change requests must be submitted at least 7 days prior to your SBU. If you wish to change your major, email orientation@uky.edu. Include your name, student ID number and new major.
- Any necessary placement exams should be completed before meeting with your advisor.
- Your Wildcard student ID isn't complete without your photo! Visit orientation.uky.edu/wildcard.
